# HOPEWELL AREA SCHOOL BOARD REGULAR WORK MEETING MAY 14, 2013

The Board of Directors of the Hopewell Area School District met in regular session on Tuesday, May 14, 2013, in the Board Room, Administration Building, 2354 Brodhead Road, Hopewell Township.

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by David Bufalini, Board President.

At this time Dr. Reina announced that there would be a presentation on the K-8 technology initiative given by Mrs. Mihok and several members of the Junior High and Elementary staff.
