

## FRENCH I – COURSE DESCRIPTION

Preliminary Chapter – Students will learn to say hello and good-bye, ask or tell a person's name, order food, express days and dates, tell time, count from 1 to 30, express simple courtesies.

Chapter 1 – Students will learn to describe people, count from 30 to 69, ask/tell where someone is from, use the verb *être* in singular forms of the present tense, use negation, make articles and adjectives agree with the words they modify.

Chapter 2 – Students will learn about school and classroom subjects, count from 70 to 100, describe people and things using plurals, speak informally and formally, use the plural forms of the verb *être* in present tense.

Chapter 3 – Students will learn about the school and school supplies, count from 100 to 1000, express likes and dislikes, use *er* verbs in the present tense.

Chapter 4 – Students will name members of the family, describe the rooms of a house or apartment, express age, use the verb *avoir* in present tense, use possessive adjectives, use some irregular adjectives.

Chapter 5 – Students will describe going to a café or restaurant and ordering food and beverages, name food items, eating utensils, and meals, express where a person is going or what a person is going to do, give locations, express possession, use the verb *aller* in present tense, use contractions of *a* and *de* with the definite article, use the verb *prendre* in present tense.

Chapter 6 – Students will describe types of food and shopping for it at different types of markets, express what one wants to do or is able to do using the present tense of the verbs *vouloir* and *pouvoir*, use the verb *faire* in present tense.

Chapter 7 – Students will describe clothing and shopping for clothing, use color words, compare two items, use the verbs *mettre*, *voir* and *croire* in present tense.
