FRENCH IV Syllabus

Chapter 8 – The students will learn about accidents and medical problems, talk about emergency room procedures, ask different types of questions, tell people what to do, compare people and things, discuss a medical emergency in France.

Chapter 9 – The students will learn to check into and out of a hotel, ask for things one needs while at a hotel, talk about past actions, refer to previously mentioned places, talk about people and things already mentioned, describe how to do things, and talk about hotels in France.

Chapter 10 – The students will learn about public transportation, request information formally and informally, tell what people have just done, find out how long someone has been doing something, discuss taking the bus and subway in Paris.

Chapter 11 – The students will learn about life in the city and the country, how to give directions, ask questions to distinguish between two or more people or things, describe more activities, discuss life on a farm in France.

Chapter 12 – The students will learn about holidays and celebrations, talk about things which may or may not happen, express what one wishes, hopes, or would like others to do, discuss some family celebrations.

Chapter 13 – The students will talk about social etiquette, introduce people to each other, describe some feelings, express opinions, discuss things that may or may not happen, express emotional reactions to what others do, compare etiquette in France and the United States.

Chapter 14 – The students will learn about professions, how to apply for a job, express doubt, express wishes about oneself and others, express certainty and uncertainty, discuss the advantages of learning French for future employment.
