

Spotted Being Good!

Dear Parents,

We work really hard on our behavior in a positive way! It is really important for you to know how your child is behaving in school on a daily basis. Each day, your child will bring home a monthly behavior Chart in their D.O.T. book. It is very important that you view the chart each day and reinforce their behavior, but also please keep the chart in their D.O.T. book so that it returns to school each day.

The rules/expectations that I reinforce in the classroom are:

- 1. Be in control
- 2. Be a good listener
- 3. Be prepared
- 4. Be a hard worker
- 5. Be kind

The students will each have a clothes pin clip with their name on it attached to a behavior chart in the classroom. Each day they will begin at the "green level" and are considered "ready to learn". If your child is a "role model" following the rules, they will move to the "blue level". If your child breaks a rule, he or she will move down to the yellow, orange, or red level each time, and will lose time from recess accordingly. If your child ends on red for the day, there will also be a write-up sent home.

Students with outstanding behavior for the month (3 or less days on yellow, orange, or red; or all blues and greens except 3) will receive a prize. Students with all blue dots for the month will receive two prizes!
